Integrity and Performance of N95 Respirators Following Decontamination for the Purpose of Reuse

A single-use, N95 filtering facepiece respirator (FFR) is recommended for protection against exposure by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH). The COVID-19 pandemic has created a shortage of personal protective equipment (PPE) and prompted an evaluation of guidelines and technology necessary to protect healthcare workers (HCWs) on the frontlines. Decontamination processes are used to extend the service lives of N95 FFRs and conserve PPE stores. The purpose of this literature review is to determine if there is a significant difference in currently available decontamination methods on the integrity and performance of N95 FFRs.
