ARTICLE TWO, Section 2.8 Electronic Meeting Meetings of the association may be conducted by telephone or other electronic means that permit simultaneous aural communication when so directed by the Board of Directors or, in the case of special meetings, when so directed by those calling the special meeting. At electronic meetings, any ballot votes required under the rules or ordered by the association shall be conducted electronically, using an internet service that supports anonymous voting. Electronic meetings of the association shall be subject to rules adopted by the associationor the board to govern such meetings, which may include any reasonable limitations on, and requirements for, members' participation. An</u> <u>anonymous vote conducted</u> <u>through the designated Internet</u> <u>meeting service shall fulfill any</u> <u>requirement in the bylaws or rules</u> <u>that a vote be conducted by</u> <u>ballot.</u>	Meetings of the members of the Association may be conducted electronically, with members who are not physically present at the meeting having the right to participate electronically, including conducting the meeting entirely through the use of an Internet meeting service designated by the president and supporting anonymous voting, visible displays identifying those participating and those seeking recognition to speak, and displaying (or permitting the retrieval of) the text of pending motions, as well as the results of votes taken at the meeting. These meeting services shall be subject to any limitations, requirements or rules adopted by the Board to govern such participation. An anonymous vote conducted through the designated Internet meeting service shall fulfill any requirement in the bylaws or rules that a vote be conducted by ballot.

Rationale: Language more clearly defines requirements and authorization of electronic meetings.
